What is the Uniform Policy?

RATIONALE - Beliefs & Values:

Uniform is compulsory – Sports uniform, Summer uniform and Winter uniform.

Summer Uniform to be worn in Terms 1 and 4.

Winter Uniform to be worn in Terms 2 and 3.

Sport uniform consists of school shorts and polo top. *Netball skirts are to be worn for netball activities only, not for regular sports days.*

A copy of the School Uniform price list is available from the office or from our website.

Please ensure that the children are correctly attired at all times at school.

This includes black leather shoes (*not black runners*) or black boots. Runners are to be worn only on sport days.

All polo tops and windcheaters should have the Holy Cross logo.

It is preferable for children to wear navy blue coats in winter. Beanies also need to be navy blue.

The Uniform Shop operates with volunteer help every Wednesday morning from 8:30 am in the Multi - Purpose Room.

WHAT MAY BE WORN:

Bomber Jacket	Windcheater	Polar Fleece Jumper
Micro Fleece Rain Coat	Polo Shirt – long or short	Shorts (can be worn everyday)
Long Trousers	Tracksuit Pants	Summer Dress
Sport Shorts	Tights (blue)	Winter Dress
White Sport Socks – <i>above ankle</i>	Runners with sport uniform	Pinafore Dress
Blue Socks – above ankle	Holy Cross School Bag	Wide Brim Hat Term 1 & 4
Black Shoes or Boots		Legionnaire Hat Term 1 & 4

- Earrings should ideally be studs that will not get hair caught in them; children may be required to remove earrings before playing particular sports
 - Jewellery should not be worn. Watches are an exception to this
 - Long hair (shoulder length or longer) needs to be tied up for both boys and girls - hair ties/headbands need to be navy blue, maroon or a Holy Cross checkered coloured scrunchie. *No large bows*
 - Children not wearing correct uniform need to have a note of explanation from their family
 - Infraction notices will be given out and monitored/followed up by the classroom teacher
 - If an item of clothing is not on this list it may not be worn
 - ***PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL ITEMS OF CLOTHING ARE CLEARLY LABELLED***
